

## Agreement on the Recognition of Domestic Driving Licences Issued by ASEAN Countries

Agreement on the Recognition of Domestic  
Driving Licences Within the ASEAN Region

As you may recall, at the 8th Meeting of the ASEAN Sub-Committee on Land Transportation (SCLT) held in Malaysia on 28-30th October, 1985, Singapore and Thailand did indicate that Annexes E, F and L to the Agreement on the Recognition of Domestic Driving Licences Within The ASEAN Region were incomplete. As such I am enclosing herewith the Annexes E, F and L as amended by Singapore and Thailand respectively.

2. I would like to seek your assistance in making the necessary amendments to the Agreement before transmitting the Agreement to ASEAN member countries for ratification.

ARTICLE 1

THE CONTRACTING PARTIES agree to recognize all domestic driving licences except for temporary/provisional/learner's driving licences (hereinafter referred to as "the licences") issued by the designated authorities or national automobile associations of the ASEAN countries. The types and classes of the licences issued in the ASEAN countries are listed in Annexes A, B, C, D, E and F for Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand respectively. Samples of the licences are also attached as Annexes G, H, I, J, K and L for Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand respectively.

ARTICLE 2

By virtue of the recognition hereby of the licences, holders of the licences issued in any one of the ASEAN countries and intending to make only a temporary stay in the territory of any of the other ASEAN countries may drive therein the classes or types of vehicles the licences permit them to drive.

ARTICLE 3

Any licences if not drawn up in English shall be accompanied by a certified translation in English.

AGREEMENT  
ON THE RECOGNITION OF DOMESTIC DRIVING  
LICENCES ISSUED BY ASEAN COUNTRIES

THE GOVERNMENT OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM, THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA, MALAYSIA, THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE AND THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO, AS "THE CONTRACTING PARTIES"):

BEING members of the Association of South East Asian Nations (hereinafter referred to as "ASEAN"):

DESIRING to accelerate and intensify the implementation of the aims and purposes of ASEAN as embodied in the ASEAN Declaration;

AND CONSIDERING the desirability of facilitating the movement of citizens of the ASEAN countries by recognizing domestic driving licences issued by the respective countries.

DO HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1

THE CONTRACTING PARTIES agree to recognize all domestic driving licences except for temporary/provisional/learner's driving licences (hereinafter referred to as "the licences") issued by the designated authorities or national automobile associations of the ASEAN countries. The types and classes of the licences issued in the ASEAN countries are listed in Annexes A, B, C, D, E and F for Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand respectively. Samples of the licences are also attached as Annexes G, H, I, J, K and L for Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand respectively.

ARTICLE 2

By virtue of the recognition hereby of the licences, holders of the licences issued in any one of the ASEAN countries and intending to make only a temporary stay in the territory of any of the other ASEAN countries may drive therein the classes or types of vehicles the licences permit them to drive.

ARTICLE 3

Any licences if not drawn up in English shall be accompanied by a certified translation in English.

ARTICLE 4

A licence which may be determined by the competent licence-issuing authority of an ASEAN country to be invalid or which according to the laws of the country in which it is issued would be invalid or which has expired shall not be recognized for the purposes of this Agreement.

ARTICLE 5

The recognition of the licences shall not absolve the holders of the licences from the responsibility of ensuring the same standard and condition of driving as applicable in the country which accords such recognition.

ARTICLE 6

Holders of the licences of one CONTRACTING PARTY shall be liable for traffic offence penalties in accordance with the appropriate laws of any other CONTRACTING PARTY in whose territory they are driving.

ARTICLE 7

Particulars of a change in the format of licences issued by any one of the CONTRACTING PARTIES should be notified accordingly to all member countries of ASEAN by the

CONTRACTING PARTY concerned. Recognition of the licences the format of which has been so changed is conditional upon such notification.

ARTICLE 8

Any amendment to this Agreement may be made by mutual consent.

ARTICLE 9

This Agreement shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of the ASEAN Secretariat who shall promptly transmit certified true copies thereof to the CONTRACTING PARTIES.

ARTICLE 10

The CONTRACTING PARTIES shall deposit their Instruments of Ratification with the Secretary-General of the ASEAN Secretariat who shall promptly inform each CONTRACTING PARTY of such deposit. This Agreement shall enter into force on the thirtieth day after the sixth Instrument of Ratification has been deposited.

ARTICLE 11

This Agreement may be terminated as between any two of the CONTRACTING PARTIES by either of the parties giving to the other six months prior written notice of the intended termination.


ARTICLE 12

Any dispute between the CONTRACTING PARTIES arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this Agreement shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation.







ANNEX B

CLASSIFICATION OF TYPES OR

ISSUED BY INDONESIA

- A : personal car, bus or truck under 2 tons (2,000 kg).
- B I : bus or truck exceeding 2 tons (2,000 kg).
- B II : tractor with a trailer or semi trailer of more than 1,000 kg.
- C : motor cycle which can be operated on level roads, at a speed exceeding 35 km/hour.
- D : motor cycle with a speed below 35 km/hour.

ANNEX C

CLASSIFICATION OF TYPES OR  
CLASSES OF DRIVING LICENCES  
ISSUED BY MALAYSIA

- B : motor cycle exceeding 500 c.c.
- B 1 : motor cycle not exceeding 500 c.c.
- B 2 : motor cycle not exceeding 250 c.c.
- B 3 : motor cycle not exceeding 90 c.c.
- C : motor cycle with side car.
- D : motor car not exceeding 3,000 kg (ULW).
- E : heavy motor car exceeding 3,000 kg (ULW).
- E 1 : heavy motor car - articulated or rigid not exceeding maximum permissible laden weight of 18 tons.
- E 2 : heavy motor car - articulated or rigid not exceeding maximum permissible laden weight of 12 tons.
- F : Tractor light - mobile machinery light (wheeled) unladen weight less than 5 tons.
- G : Tractor light - mobile machinery light (tracked) unladen weight less than 5 tons.
- H : Tractor heavy - mobile machinery heavy (wheeled) unladen weight exceeding 5 tons.
- I : Tractor heavy - mobile machinery heavy (tracked) unladen weight exceeding 5 tons.

For both Non-Professional and Professional Driver's Licences

Restriction Code 1 : motor cycles/motorized tricycles.

4,500 kg.

Restriction Code 4 : Automatic clutch only.

Restriction Code 5 : Articulated vehicles

Restriction Code 6 : Needs corrective lenses

- Class 1 : Invalid carriages

- Class 3 : Motor cars and Motor Tractors the weight of which unladen does not exceed 2500 kg.
- Class 4A : Heavy Motor Cars and Motor Tractors the weight of which unladen exceeds 2500 kg.
- Class 5 : Motor Vehicles which are not constructed themselves to carry any load and the weight of which unladen exceeds 7250 kg.

ANNEX E

CLASSIFICATION OF TYPES OR  
CLASSES OF DRIVING LICENCES  
ISSUED BY SINGAPORE

- Class 1 : Invalid carriages
- Class 2B : Motor cycles not exceeding 200 c.c.
- Class 2A : Motor cycles between 201 c.c. and 400 c.c.
- Class 2 : Motor cycles exceeding 400 c.c.
- Class 3 : Motor cars and Motor Tractors the weight of which unladen does not exceed 2500 kg.
- Class 4 : Heavy Motor Cars and Motor Tractors the weight of which unladen exceeds 2500 kg.
- Class 4A : Omnibuses
- Class 5 : Motor Vehicles which are not constructed themselves to carry any load and the weight of which unladen exceeds 7250 kg.

ANNEX F

CLASSIFICATION OF TYPES OR  
CLASSES OF DRIVING LICENCES  
ISSUED BY THAILAND

Group 1

- 1 Driving Licences for Private Transportation for driving a vehicle of weight inclusive of weight of the load, not exceeding 4,000 kg. which is not used in the transport of passenger, or for driving a vehicle carrying not exceeding 20 passengers.
- 2 for driving a vehicle of weight inclusive of the weight of the load, exceeding 4,000 kg. which is not used in the transport of passenger or for driving a vehicle carrying more than 20 passengers.
- 3 for driving a vehicle which is by nature, used for drawing other vehicles or any wheeled car which carried anything thereon (trailer)

Group 2

- Driving Licences for A 11 Types of Transportation (fixed route, non-fixed route, mini buses, and private).
- 1 for driving a vehicle of weight inclusive of weight of the load, not exceeding 4,000 kg. which is not used in the transport of passenger, or for driving a vehicle carrying not exceeding 20 passengers.
- 2 for driving a vehicle of weight inclusive of the weight of the load, exceeding 4,000 kg. which is not used in the transport of passenger or for driving a vehicle carrying more than 20 passengers.
- 3 for driving a vehicle which is by nature, used for drawing other vehicles or any wheeled car which carried anything thereon (trailers).

ANNEX F

CLASSIFICATION OF TYPES OR  
CLASSES OF DRIVING LICENCES  
ISSUED BY THAILAND

1. Issued by Police Department

There are 9 types of driving licences :

- (1) Temporary driving licence for rented private automobile, private motor tricycle and motorcycle.
- (2) Driving licence for private automobile
- (3) Driving licence for private motor tricycle
- (4) Driving licence for public automobile
- (5) Driving licence for public motor tricycle
- (6) Driving licence for motorcycle
- (7) Driving licence for road roller
- (8) Driving licence for tractor
- (9) Driving licence for vehicles other than those mentioned in (1) to (8) above

2. Issued by Department of Land Transport


## **SECOND PROTOCOL FOR THE ACCESSION OF THE UNION OF MYANMAR TO ASEAN AGREEMENTS**

1. **WHEREAS** the Union of Myanmar became a Member State of ASEAN on 23 July 1997;
2. **WHEREAS** the Union of Myanmar has agreed to subscribe or accede, as the case may be, to all Declarations, Treaties and Agreements of ASEAN;
3. **WHEREAS** the Union of Myanmar signed the Protocol for the Accession of the Union of Myanmar to ASEAN Agreements on 23 July 1997 in Subang Jaya, Malaysia; and
4. **WHEREAS** there have been consultations and negotiations directed towards the accession of the Union of Myanmar to Agreements of ASEAN and the commitments made by the Union of Myanmar in the signed letter from the Minister for National Planning and Economic Development to the Chairman of the 28th ASEAN Economic Ministers Meeting dated 12 May 1997;
5. **NOW THEREFORE** the Government of the Union of Myanmar hereby accedes to the following Agreements:

- I** **Agreement for the Promotion of Cooperation in Mass Media and Cultural Activities**, signed in Cameron Highlands, Malaysia, on 17 December 1969
- II** **Multilateral Agreement on Commercial Rights of Non-Scheduled Services among ASEAN**, signed in Manila on 13 March 1971

- III Agreement for the Facilitation of Search for Aircraft in Distress and Rescue of Survivors of Aircraft Accidents**, signed in Singapore on 14 April 1972
- IV Agreement for the Facilitation of Search of Ships in Distress and Rescue of Survivors of Ship Accidents**, signed in Kuala Lumpur on 15 May 1975
- V Agreement on the Recognition of Domestic Driving Licences Issued by ASEAN Countries**, signed in Kuala Lumpur on 9 July 1985 and the amendment thereto in the Protocol to Amend ASEAN Agreements signed in Subang Jaya, Malaysia, on 23 July 1997
- VI Agreement on the Conservation of Nature and Natural Resources**, signed in Kuala Lumpur on 9 July 1985
- VII Agreement on ASEAN Energy Cooperation**, signed in Manila on 24 June 1986 and the amendments thereto in the Protocols signed in Bangkok on 15 December 1995 and in Subang Jaya, Malaysia, on 23 July 1997
- VIII ASEAN Petroleum Security Agreement**, signed in Manila on 24 June 1986 and the amendment thereto in the Protocol to Amend ASEAN Agreements signed in Subang Jaya, Malaysia, on 23 July 1997
- IX Agreement on the Preferential Shortlisting of ASEAN Contractors**, signed in Jakarta on 20 October 1986 and the amendment thereto in the Protocol to Amend ASEAN Agreements signed in Subang Jaya, Malaysia, on 23 July 1997



## Annex 1

**Specific Conditions for the Accession  
of the Union of Myanmar  
to the Agreement for the Facilitation of Search of  
Ships in Distress and Rescue of Survivors of Ship Accidents  
Kuala Lumpur, 15 May 1975**

++++++

1. WHEREAS the Agreement for the Facilitation of Search of Ships in Distress and Rescue of Survivors of Ship Accidents was signed by the Governments of the Republic of Indonesia, Malaysia, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore and the Kingdom of Thailand in Kuala Lumpur on 15 May 1975;
2. WHEREAS the Governments of Brunei Darussalam and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam acceded to the Agreement on 2 September 1996 and 20 February 1997 respectively;
3. AND WHEREAS the Union of Myanmar became a Member State of ASEAN on 23 July 1997 and has agreed to subscribe or accede, as the case may be, to all Declarations, Treaties and Agreements of ASEAN;
4. NOW THEREFORE the Government of the Union of Myanmar hereby accedes to the Agreement for the Facilitation of Search of Ships in Distress and Rescue of Survivors of Ship Accidents and undertakes to immediately observe and carry out its obligations under the Agreement with the following specific conditions:

- I. The Agreement shall not be applicable to State ships used in conflict for purposes of aggression.
- II. Ships, including submarines, used in military, naval, customs, public services and private carriers requisitioned by State in conflict, carrying cargoes and passengers (troops or personnel to be used in combats) shall be deemed to be State ships.

6. **THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNION OF MYANMAR** hereby agrees to, from the date of its accession to the above Agreements, immediately observe the commitments and carry out the obligations under the Agreements, any amendment thereto, and the specific conditions contained in Annex 1.


7. This Protocol shall enter into force on the day of its signing.

8. This Protocol shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of ASEAN, who shall promptly furnish a certified copy thereof to each Member State of ASEAN.
